

The Hillyfield, Land lying south of Harbourneford: Hillyfield plantation and Toms Brake, South Brent, Devon.

I support the appellant in appealing against the enforcement notice, and in support for granting the prior notification for two forestry buildings for the drying of timber and storage of machinery. Our family have lived in Harbourneford for over 22 years and over most of these years before Mr King Smith took over the woodland it was sadly neglected and very poorly managed. The accesses to the woods were also previously forbidden, to villagers, with one owner putting up many aggressive signs at all the entrances. None of these owners seemed to manage the wood and fish ponds were put in in that were barely used.

Since Mr King Smith's ownership there has been a complete and professional change in the management of the woodland.

They are managed in a careful, sustainable and inclusive way.

Due to all his hard work the woodlands are coming back to life; the wild flowers are returning and wild life is moving back.

They have had, out of nececity, had to use some make shift structures to be able to do this work, with seasonal workers accommodation, and a tented structure for them to have meals and breaks and shelter from the rain, all vital for them to be able to undertake the impressive work that they have been doing.

I have seen these structures and they are very low impact and are not visible, from any road or from the village and do not cause a disturbance to neighbours.

My family have participated as volunteers and attended some of the woodland skills workshops, which have been fascinating and educational.

We tried in the beginning to buy our logs from the woodland project but due to no dry areas, for storing wood on the site, we had to stop.

The temporary wood drying barn has made a huge difference to the quality of the logs, and we have been buying all our logs from Mr King Smith this winter.

A new permanent wood drying barn is essential if this venture is to succeed, and a properly constructed and covered area to store his valuable tools. Mr King –Smith has always been approachable and kept everyone in the village well informed of all proposed plans and development, which we thoroughly appreciate.

I am a keen supporter of the Dartmoor National Parks and support many of their planning decisions, but in this case they have got it completely wrong.

The proposed buildings are essential to properly manage this woodland. It now has its own private access, and most importantly it has allowed my family and many local residents to enjoy this special corner of the national park previously excluded to the local community.

I truly hope you will support this appeal, as it is vital to the success of the project that it becomes financially viable and most of the village of Harbourneford fully support it.

#### TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

We are writing in support of your appellant Doug King-Smith concerning The Hillyfield, Land Lying South of Harbourneford: Hillyfield Plantation and Tom's Brake, South Brent.

We have been working with Doug on a part-time basis since April 2013, helping him to set-up his poultry and egg business, Hillyfield Hens. Keeping poultry in a woodland setting, next to a river, as he does at The Hillyfield, is not without its challenges - particularly from predators - and we have been truly impressed by Doug's enthusiasm to create an environment that is safe for the birds and yet still in keeping with the surroundings.

We have used as many materials as possible from the site (including fence posts from Hillyfield trees felled due to Larch disease and sawdust from the mobile wood mill as bedding).

But what particularly sets The Hillyfield project apart from poultry businesses is the involvement of the community and volunteer workers - indeed it has made it possible to establish a sustainable forestry business.

For example, seasonal forestry workers (who have come to The Hillyfield to help in the woods through the Worldwide Opportunities on Organic farms scheme) have also been on-hand to open chicken houses and feed the birds in the morning (saving us regular journeys form our homes in Totnes) and to help with some of the many jobs requiring more hands: repairing and moving chicken houses etc..

WWOOFers come from across the country, and across the world, of course, so they have taken knowledge and expertise gained at The Hillyfield across the globe (and brought us a few ideas of their own).

The Hillyfield also hosts regular monthly volunteer days, when members of the surrounding community spend a day working on the land. Their work often includes helping out with work around the chickens, and again there has been much help given and ideas exchanged. This is the first time we have worked closely with voluntary workers and we have been genuinely moved by their enthusiasm and eagerness to get involved. We have spoken and worked with many of them over the past three years and they have unanimously expressed their gratitude that Doug gives them the opportunity to get involved and experience the magical surroundings of The Hillyfield woodland farm.

On a more personal level, we have always found Doug and his helpers to be the perfect mix of friendly and professional, making working with them a pleasurable and rewarding experience. He has a true love of the land and a seemingly endless capacity to put in that little bit extra work to do it right - for the land, for the community and for future generations.

We have also always been encouraged to invite our adult children and their children to visit and spend time at The Hillyfield and I know they would all join us in thanking Doug for the opportunity to get away from their urban lives and experience nature 'hands-on'.

We are now moving on to set-up our own enterprise with a neighbouring farmer, closer to our home, but we will continue to collaborate and share knowledge and resources - we wouldn't want our relationship with The Hillyfield to end completely. The Hillyfield, and Doug's enthusiasm and leadership skills, have also inspired us to encourage community involvement at our new project and we will always be grateful to him for that.

I support the appellant in appealing against the enforcement notice, and against the refusal to grant the prior notification for the two forestry buildings for the drying of timber and storage of machinery, which this woodland clearly needs. It seems a great pity to see such investment in equipment and in felling and planting timber suffer in the elements.

We also believe there is an obvious need for facilities such as the compost toilet and field kitchen, for WWOOFers and voluntary workers, and the tool store, providing secure and weatherproof accommodation for the tools and equipment, which are vital to the business.

They are managing the land sensitively, creating diversity in native ecosystems with hedgerows, orchards, and native species being planted.

They are also creating a strong rural business which supports the local community. We as a business want to order timber from Hillyfields to support our outcomes. We support adults with learning difficulties by providing worthwhile training opportunities on our farm managed for conservation, they are making bat boxes to help with this end and these products are also being sold in the local community and further afield through NHBS (Natural history book store) in Totnes. Having all aspects of this operation being supported by local businesses (hillyfiled) means that the local economy thrives, sustainably increases (not importing timber) and there is a very real learning story for the adults with learning difficulties and equally the customers that buy the products, as they can see full cycle where the timber has come from, how and where it is made and know that it is sold from a local shop. The Hillyfield needs the timber drying barns and associated structures (workshops, tool storage) to carry out their work and thus meet their supply demands, of which we are one.

We also see that taking the adults with learning disabilities and other trainees that come to the farm, to Hillyfields will really support them. It is a chance to see where the wood that they are using has come from and with that how forestry can be undertaken in a sensitive way, how areas can be regenerated with native species. It also gives them a chance to partake in the wider community, see other parts of Devon and the fantastic landscape that is Dartmoor. For this we also see why structures such as compost loo's and kitchen facilities are needed, to support seasonal workers and in our case trainees that might visit Hillyfield.

I spent over two months staying and working at the Hillyfield as a residential seasonal forestry worker (Oct & November 2015, Jan & Feb 2016) and have also volunteered at the monthly volunteer weekends. During my stay as a residential volunteer I stayed in the Yurt and participated daily in a range of forestry work including; assisting tree felling, clearing brash, tackling invasive species in undergrowth, processing firewood and sawmill timber. Before coming to the Hillyfield I had very little forestry experience and came from an urban background. I really wanted the opportunity to spend some time in nature and gain some new skills to help me make a transition to a different employment sector and way of life.


I feel very fortunate to have been able to have been able to experience such a beautiful site whilst gaining experience in sustainable forestry management working alongside Doug. I definitely feel the new skills I gained whilst at the Hillyfield helped me both find paid work on a tree nursery and later gain a place on a practical residency in sustainable horticulture (that I am now undertaking). Doug's support and careful management helped me gain confidence in myself and improve my leadership skills, especially when I was able to help lead the weekend volunteer days. Before coming I knew very little about the importance of regenerating woodland and sustainable forestry management practices (such as maximising wildlife habitats and protecting nesting birds by careful timing of different activities). Inspired by Doug's work I want to become more actively involved in woodland work having since witnessed many unmanged woods and seen the need for woodland regeneration on Dartmoor. I also witnessed how grateful many customers were to be able to buy dry local sustainably sourced firewood, demonstrating a local demand for the work Doug does.

Doug is very hard working dedicating a lot of energy, time and resources to try and protect and maintain the Hillyfield trying to make a marginal livelihood from the essential woodland work. I witnessed the need for lots of people working together on jobs such as tree felling and brash clearing to ensure a tidy job is completed without unnecessary ecosystem damage being done (especially on a steep woodled site).

I can confirm that the work occurs in all weathers (wet, windy, snowy) making a simple 'weather-proof' shelter (the crew tent) invaluable to have breaks/lunch in. Whilst stacking wood in very wet conditions, I appreciated the need to have a wood shelter for the final dry. As a female having a compost toilet made working on site practical, especially at the busier volunteer days with lots of workers on site. A place for the volunteer seasonal forestry workers to stay on the land means a much broader group of people are given the opportunity to come and work. Without the crew tent (kitchen), compost toilet or yurt, I (and not doubt many others too) would not have been able to come to the Hillyfield, a thought which greatly saddens me. For many people the 'live in' volunteering opportunities provided at the Hillyfield could be the only opportunity available to engage with woodland work, whilst witnessing the beauty of Dartmoor. Doug is very clear that you only stay for the length of time you work as a seasonal forestry worker, and I can confirm that there was nobody staying on site during my stays who was not working hard daily in the woods.

It has been beautiful to witness the interactions between volunteers from all walks of life and ages, connecting with nature whilst learning useful skills, helping spread sustainable forestry practices further. I meet many other people volunteering all who had been positively transformed in some way by the woods and the work completed on site. The monthly volunteer days, help make the woods a community asset, enjoyed by many. I really hope the amazing work carried out by Doug can continue and that many other volunteers like myself can continue to be enriched by the site.
